Who is Pillar for?

Pillar is for people who have experienced mental illness or mental health problems. Some of the difficulties that can be experienced by people with mental health problems are a lack of confidence and low self esteem, loneliness and isolation, and a feeling of helplessness and hopelessness.

What does Pillar provide:

Pillar can offer the chance to meet other people and have somewhere to go to socialise and try new groups and activities. Workers can also provide comprehensive advice and information on where and how to access other resources and services and offer support and advice during times of difficulty.



Pillar provides drop in sessions 6 days a week and a range of small group activities and discussion groups. Pillar encourages members to help and support each other with the aid of workers who help people to socialise and talk together during sessions and groups.

Funding:

Pillar Aberdeen is recognised by Inland Revenue as a Charity (SC014866) and very much rely on any donation no matter how small.

One of Pillar's main sources of funding comes from Aberdeen City Council's Social Work budget.

A donation is worth more with Gift Aid.

What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is a simple way for our charity to increase the value of gifts of money we receive from UK taxpayers.

How does it work?

When a UK Tax payer gives a gift of money to a charity, tax has already been paid on that money. This money therefore qualifies for Gift Aid. Because we are exempt from tax, we can claim an amount equal to the tax paid by a donor on their donation as a repayment from HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC)

How much is Gift Aid worth?

Gift Aid allows us to claim back 25p for every £1 you give to us, boosting the value of your donation by a quarter. All we need from you is permission to claim back the tax you have already paid to HMRC.

What do I need to do?
